Welcome to the Asbury UMC Core Values Booklet! Our Church Family has come together to create six Core Values. In this booklet we want to share those Core Values with you and get your input in order that we may finalize them.

On the following pages you will see our Core Values as they have emerged through our meetings. Each Core Value will have its own page. For each Core Value page you will see four things. You will see:

- 1. All the ideas our groups have come up with these will be grouped at the top in a box with a dashed line
- 2. The Title of the Core Value, or in some cases more than one Title for the Core Value
- 3. Example supporting descriptions of the Core Value
- 4. Example supporting verses for the Core Value

Please review each Core Value's Title, supporting description, and supporting verses.

If you agree with the Title of the Core Value, circle it. If you have a better Title for the Core Value, write it in the space below the Title. Do the same thing for the supporting description and supporting verse on each page. A special note about the scripture: The example scriptures are NIV. If you prefer a different version please note that as well.
